wheels touching

Place carts with Ensure carts are at least one metre (3 feet) from parked vehicles and fixed objects

Leave enough space for you to walk around the carts










Carts must NOT block lanes or roads

Carts will NOT be collected from enclosures



- All carts must be placed out for collection no later than 7 a.m. on your collection day.
- Lids closed
- Carts must be returned to your property at the end of the day
